Uniforms for CTMB Members must be returned after every performance.
Formal Marching Uniform will be worn 3-4 times a year. It consists of

four (4) pieces: *Jacket, pants, coverall, hat w/plum*. A one time, non-refundable payment of \$100.00 is required to participate in the band. The money is used to maintain the uniform. Students will be responsible for damage done to the uniforms. Please note the following:

*\$300.00 if the suit is not returned complete.
Required - White gloves and white spats.
